FAQ

Why do you hold camps? - For over 60 years Thames Valley Christian camps (TVCC) has provided lively, low-cost holidays for young people in an atmosphere in which campers are encouraged to consider and accept the truths of the Christian Faith and apply them in their own lives.

Who are you? - TVCC is overseen by a committee drawn from various independent evangelical churches in the Thames Valley area. It provides holidays run by experienced teams of Christians. Each camp has a spiritual leader who gives a simple Bible talk each day and is available for help and advice.

Where does the camp take place? - Hampshire Christian Trust campsite at Lockerley Water Farm, East Tytherley Road, Lockerley, Hants, SO510LW.

How do you get there? - You can make your own way to and from camp but most groups provide their own transport (please check with your local leaders). Minibuses are used for transporting during camp. Arrival around 8.00pm on Friday evening and camp finishes at 4.00pm on the Tuesday afternoon.

What is the accommodation like? - Accommodation is in cabins with typically 7 or 8 campers per group. Each group is looked after by 2 adult team leaders. The site has indoor facilities for dining, toilets and showers.

Safeguarding - TVCC has a Safeguarding policy covering all aspects of our work with children and teenagers. All leaders and helpers receive Safeguarding training and are DBS checked.
